At ESA’s biannual Conference in Athens in August 2017 the Research network “Environment and Society” (RN12) had 26 sessions with four to five papers including two joint sessions. A wide disciplinary participation to our sessions RN12 supports the openness of our network to new participants also from outside sociology. In between the conferences there is a good communication and exchange through our mailing list with currently about 750 addresses. The list is excellently maintained by Çigdem Adem. From September 12-14, 2016 we held our Midterm conference together with the Energy and Society Group. The title was “Transforming Energy for Society. The conference was held at the “Kubus” of Helmholtz Centre for Environmental Research – UFZ in Leipzig, Germany. The conference included 26 thematic panels of oral presentations (each one with 4 to 5 papers) and two keynote speeches, one by Debra Davidson (University of Alberta, Canada) on “Can we adapt? An evolutionary lens on future energy-society relations” and the other one by Patrick Devine-Wright (University of Exeter, UK) on “Community Energy: Rescaling energy systems for the low carbon transition.
